

Temperpedic Beds: An Summary of Basic Beds Sold by Temperpedic

The Original Bed

Temperpedic Bed's Original Bed is based on the company's first design, released over ten years ago. It's constructed using a top layer of their state-of-the-art TEMPUR material and is made to conform to the human body with the obvious goal of offering a more relaxing night's sleep.

The Original Bed sleep system also comes with a soft, terry cloth cover that helps prevent penetration by dust, mites, mold and other allergens. It's removable and washable as well.

Temperpedic Symphony Sleep System

The Symphony Bed was Temperpedic's first product with an AirFlo base layer. It's made with a convoluted foam that's designed to increase air circulation and improve your internal temperature control while you sleep.

The TEMPUR layer offers both what the manufacturer calls a comfort layer and a support layer, one to offer a soft and supportive sleep surface and the other intended to reduce impact on the body's pressure points for a better supported sleep.

Temperpedic Celebrity Sleep System

What makes the Celebrity Bed sleep system different from other Temperpedic Beds is its cashmere-blend mattress cover and pillow-top sleeping surface. Along with its basic materials, this bed also has a mattress height of 13.5 inches and an adjustable bed base. The Celebrity is advertised as a luxurious bed.

Temperpedic Grand Bed Sleep System

The Grand Bed is advertised as the highest quality sleep system in the Temperpedic Beds' range of mattress products. It sits 14.5 inches high, is comprised of TEMPUR-HD, a new blend of the TEMPUR material, covered with quilted silk and satin, and is accompanied by the company's strongest foundation system.

Prices for Temperpedic Sleep Systems

A basic Twin Original Bed will cost most consumers approximately \$700 if they pay full sticker price. Meanwhile, a King Original runs between \$1400 and \$1500, depending on the point of purchase. Meanwhile, the Grand Bed systems can cost as much as \$6700. These are pretty high costs for average buyers who may simply want a fairly comfortable, basic mattress.

If prices are steep, you could weight the option of the company's no interest financing plan for qualified consumers. Alternatively, Temperpedic sells accessories like mattress pads and pillows, making the TEMPUR experience accessible for all consumers.
