For these people, canister machines are the only ones that work properly and keep their delicate items from being destroyed. When people clean their homes they want to make things look better, not worse, and the wrong kind of cleaning machine can be a serious problem for them.

It is easy to damage a lot of things in a person's home and people often don't realize how quickly this can happen. It can be especially problematic for people who just got something new – or inherited something old – and aren't really that sure how to take care of it. For them, cleaning may be difficult. It can also be costly if they don't take the time to learn how to clean something properly before they start trying to take care of it. The unfortunate thing with these issues is that they can take place before you realize it and they can be irreparable.
